# CASE MANAGEMENT

Are you interested in helping others? A career in case management may be right for you! A case manager is someone who coordinates services on behalf of individuals or families. They typically work in mental health facilities, hospitals, clinics, nursing homes, schools, community social service agencies or organizations, local and state government offices, or in the legal profession.

### ***For undergraduate students or working adults***

This certificate program is appropriate for undergraduate students who are majoring in psychology or other disciplines, like business, nursing, education, or liberal arts.

It is also a great way for working adults and non-degree seeking students who only want to complete the courses required for the certificate to give their careers a boost.

Either way, you'll get specialized education and training that includes:

- Working with diverse populations in community settings
- Locating and obtaining community resources, including funding
- Developing and implementing behavior management and improvement plans
- Fostering collaborative problem-solving and networking
- Mentoring and teaching life skills

### ***Program requirements and courses***

This certificate program consists of 19 credits (not including any required prerequisites). Required courses include:

PSY-B310	Life Span Development (3 cr.) <i>Prerequisites: Three (3) credits of psychology</i>
PSY-B321	Clinical Writing (1 cr.)
PSY-B325	Professional Ethics (1 cr.)
PSY-B328	Working with families (2 cr.)
PSY-B380	Abnormal Psychology (3 cr.) <i>Prerequisite: Three (3) credits of psychology</i>
PSY-B386	Introduction to Counseling (3 cr.) <i>Prerequisites: PSY-B104, B310, and B380</i>
PSY-B422	Professional Practice in Case Management (3 cr.) <i>Prerequisite: Three (3) credits of psychology and instructor consent</i>
