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## Scope

Indiana University Purdue University Columbus (IUPUC) Division of Health Sciences.

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## Policy Statement

Students may be included on division and university committees which address curriculum and/ or student life matters, or on committees where student input is valuable to the work of the committee. Any administrative committees and any committee that covers material protected under FERPA are excluded from this policy and students will not be allowed to attend. Information protected under FERPA should only be discussed at Admission, Progression, and Graduation (APG) Committee meetings.

Selection of students to serve on committees may be made by appointment of the chair of the committee or a task force designated to make a recommendation. The student selected must be in good standing in the University and have no professionalism issues on file in the health sciences division as confirmed by the health sciences advisors. The committee may specify criteria for student selection, such as undergraduate/graduate status, program status, grade point average, advising notes, etc. Students may be appointed as non-voting members. The chair of the committee reserves the right to dismiss the student representative from the committee at their discretion. Such reasons for dismissal may include academic misconduct, and professionalism issues.

In addition to membership on committees, student representation may be included on ad hoc committees as needed. Student representation will be included in Synergy Curriculum and the division's Advisory Council meetings.

To provide opportunities for student engagement and program improvement created by student representation on committees in the Division of Health Sciences Program.
