Division of Health Sciences COVID-19 Guidelines

On-campus COVID-19 guidelines:

- Faculty, staff, and students must self-assess for suspected COVID-19 symptoms, possible exposure, and temperature before arriving on campus.

For instruction on exposure, students should consult the Indiana University (IU) policy.

COVID-19 requirements for clinical settings:

- Students can care for COVID-positive patients or suspected COVID-positive patients.
- If students have suspected symptoms of COVID or a fever on the morning of their practicum, they must notify their practicum instructor, and stay home. Students who develop suspicious symptoms during the clinical day will be sent home and referred to IU Covid policy.
- Appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) will be provided to all students in practicum. Fit testing will be required during practicum orientation.
- Students must follow facility guidelines for the type of PPE to be worn.

Additional faculty guidelines:

- Practicum faculty may be fit-tested and follow the same screening guidelines as students.
